You can claim up to 80% of your childcare costs back!

Child Tax Credits is a means-tested allowance for parents and carers of children and young people who are still in full-time education.

This is because childcare vouchers are Non-Taxable and exempt from National Insurance Contributions up to £217 per parent per month. These vouchers can be used at HASC. HASC is registered with Busy Bees and Care4, approved childcare voucher agencies.
